





Dr. Arielle Medford (Massachusetts General Hospital) will use support from her Young Investigator Award (YIA) to study precision therapy in breast cancer based on genomic targets; Dr. Stephanie Smith (Stanford University) will use a Career Development Award to help improve survivorship care for young Latinx cancer survivors in Salinas Valley, California; Dr. Sarah Nyagabona (Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences, Tanzania) will use a Global Oncology YIA to research drivers of survival disparity for women with breast cancer who are also living with HIV and help inform the development of a user-friendly care model; and Dr. Shakilu Jummane (The University of Dodoma, Tanzania) will use support from an International Innovation Grant to implement a training program for primary health care providers in Tanzania to improve early detection of retinoblastoma in children.

These patient-centric grants are just a few examples of the vital programs our donors make possible. Conquer Cancer is the world's largest funder of early career oncology researchers, with no limits on their geography or focus area. The impact of this work on patients is immense. The Conquer Cancer Grants & Awards program provides the critical support necessary for physician-scientists to uncover treatments and cures, find new and innovative ways to include patients in the research process, and collaborate with patients to improve cancer care.

Launched in 2016, this award program recognizes extraordinary female leaders in oncology and role models who have excelled as mentors and have demonstrated outstanding commitment to the professional development of women colleagues as clinicians, educators, and researchers in oncology. The awards seek to recognize and promote the work of women mentors in oncology and, ultimately, narrow career gender disparities through the mentorship and professional development of women oncology professionals.

**Carolyn D. Runowicz, MD**, is a tenured Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Herbert Wertheim College of Medicine Florida International University at Miami, Florida. She is a nationally and internationally recognized leader in women's health and gynecologic cancer. Her research has focused on the development, initiation and conduct of clinical trials in gynecologic cancer and in cancer prevention. She has authored more than 200 scientific articles and 5 books. She has received numerous honors and awards, including the 2018 Distinguished Service Award by the Society of Gynecologic Oncology. She is also the recipient of the University of Connecticut Distinguished Alumni Award, the American Medical Women's Association Local Legend Award, Cancer Care Physician of the Year Award, and many others. She serves as a role model and mentor for faculty, residents, and students. She has served in leadership roles in the major cancer organizations. She served on the Board of Directors of the American Society of Clinical Oncology (2011-2015) as the first gynecologic oncologist. She served as the first woman president of the Society of Gynecologic Oncologists (2000), was President of the American Cancer Society (2005) and served on the National Cancer Advisory Board (NCAB), appointed by President George W. Bush. She served as Chair of the NCAB for 4 years (2006-2010). She completed 2 terms as Vice President of the American Gynecological and Obstetrical Foundation Board. She has initiated and led many innovative clinical trials in the development of novel therapies for gynecologic cancers.
